

Andrey Mashinyan is the Director of the Irish Cultural Centre in St. Petersburg, Russia. Since 21.12.2018 the Centre has its academic basis and permanent office in the Russian State Pedagogical University, St. Petersburg. Dr Mashinyan's interests include Irish history and mythology, life and works of W.B. Yeats and J. Joyce, connections between Irish Celtic Revival and Russian Silver Age. He holds a PhD in Irish Literature, author of dissertation "Mythological poetics of W.B. Yeats", author of two published books of translations of poetry and plays by W.B. Yeats and a published book of translations of works by J. Joyce. Dr. Mashinyan is a member of the International W.B. Yeats Society, curator of the annual festivals of Irish Culture in St. Petersburg, festivals of St. Petersburg in Dublin and Cork, chair at the annual International Bloomsday Conference "Ireland and Russia: the past and the present".
