*Volume 3-5 pages. Page format - A4. Font - Times New Roman (without styles), size 14 pt. ; all fields - 2 cm; word hyphenation is automatic. Line spacing - single. Paragraph - 1.25 cm. Illustrations (resolution not less than 300 dpi.) In the text (please do not use "text wrap"). References to literature in square brackets. References - alphabetically, full names of authors in lower case letters. Pages are not numbered. Abstract and Keywords are placed before the text. After the list of references - the abstract in English (12 pt.). **The structure of the text necessarily includes the following sections: Introduction, Objects and Methods, Discussion of Results, Conclusions, Literature**, separated by a single line. Materials are published in the author's edition. Articles are accepted in English.*

S u m m a r y. The north-west part of the East-European Plain, is considered traditionally as the zone without gullies. Nevertheless, under certain natural conditions the human intervention may cause the development of gully erosion here. The gully situated in the valley of the Ifenka River on the south of Leningrad region is described as an example.
