The conference's working languages are Russian and English.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to select reports based on their relevance to the conference theme, as determined by double-blind peer review. Authors will be notified about the decision of the Organizing Committee before March 01, 2021.

Abstracts for the electronic digest are accepted until April 01, 2021. Texts must be formatted according to the requirements of the RSCI (requirements will be sent in the information letter No.2). Abstracts will be published in the authors' edition.
